San Antonio Jewish Senior Services (SAJSS) is heartbroken by the passing of **Perry Douglas Wulfe** (z"l), a deeply dedicated and beloved SAJSS volunteer and member of the community. For 40+ years, Perry was involved with Golden Manor/SAJSS as a Past President and member of the Board of Directors, as well as Secretary/Treasurer of Jewish Care System of San Antonio.

Perry will be remembered for many things. He was intelligent, warm, witty, caring, independent, generous, and a great community leader. He was the CFO/CIO of his family business, Alamo Aircraft Ltd. He loved Star Wars, Star Trek, the St. Louis Cardinals, Texas Longhorns, Dallas Cowboys, and San Antonio Spurs. He was quite a sports memorabilia collector too. *(Cont. on page 2)*



Fast of the 17th of Tammuz • Tuesday, July 23

Commemorates the many calamities faced by the Jewish people on this day through the years:

- Moses came down from Mt. Sinai and broke the first set of Tablets in response to the Golden Calf.
- In 586 BCE, the walls of Jerusalem were breached during the siege by Nebuchadnezzar and the Babylonian armies.
- In 70 CE, Titus and the Romans again breached the walls of Jerusalem.
- In 1391, more than 4,000 Jews were killed in Spain.
- In 1559, the Jewish Quarter of Prague was looted and burned.
- In 1755, Chief Rabbi Yitzchak Hakohen Rappaport passed away.
- In 1944, the Kovno ghetto was liquidated.

Also, on this day:

- Noah sent the first dove to check if the flood waters had receded.
- Moses destroyed the Golden Calf and ascended Mt. Sinai for the second time.
- The Three Weeks begins, a yearly mourning period over the destruction of the First and Second Temples in Jerusalem.
